4. Describe your financial needs and how this scholarship will help you pay for your education.

If necessary, personal interviews will be conducted in January. Selected recipients will be introduced at the closing luncheon of Woman's World on Saturday, February 24, 2018. They will also be asked to help assist with different functions of the conference throughout the weekend. This is an important part of the scholarship, so please let us know if you will not be able to attend the conference.

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## *2018-2019 Woman's World Scholarship*

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**M**anhattan Christian College is pleased to offer the 2018-2019 Woman's World Scholarship. In 1984, MCC Women started this scholarship opportunity in connection with the annual Woman's World Conference. The students chosen to receive these scholarships will be honored during the Saturday noon lunch session of Woman's World on February 24, 2018. The scholarships will be awarded for the 2018-2019 academic year. Completed applications should be submitted by December 15, 2017.

### *2018-2019 Woman's World Scholarship Qualifications/Requirements*

1. Female students who have completed at least 30 MCC hours at the end of the fall 2017 semester.
2. Applicants must be degree-seeking students and enrolled full time, either at MCC or in a MCC/KSU dual-degree program.
3. Scholarship recipients will be chosen on the basis of their spiritual growth and involvement, academic standing, and financial need.
4. In order for a scholarship application to be considered, the file must be completed and submitted by December 15, 2017. Recommendation letters must be received by January 19, 2018 for the scholarship application to be considered complete.
5. The scholarship will be granted for the 2018-2019 academic year and is to be used for educational purposes only. The amount of the award will be credited to the recipient's MCC account, divided evenly between the fall and spring semesters. The award may be applied toward MCC tuition, room and board at MCC, withdrawn as cash for books, applied toward off-campus housing, or used for KSU fees.
6. This scholarship may be awarded only once during a recipient's MCC academic career. It is not renewable.

All criteria must be met and maintained or the award will be given to alternate recipients chosen at the time of the initial interviews.
