Registration – Registration is between 5:30pm and 6pm in the Campus Center. The Campus Center is located at 1427 Laramie. (Between Laramie Street and Fairchild Avenue.) If for any reason you cannot make this check-in time, please text Jenny Herrera at 785-477-6730.

Application – Your Application for Admission is required in order to interview for the Timothy Days Leadership Scholarship. If you have not already done so, please go online www.mccks.edu/high-school-checklist and submit your application.

Parking – Parking is available in the Staff/Faculty parking lot as well as in the Student parking lot. The entrance to the parking lot is located on Fairchild Avenue.
